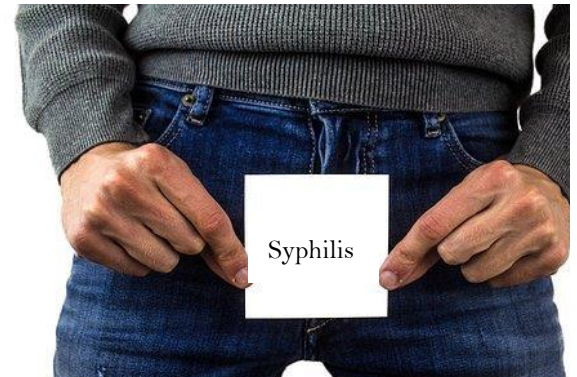
# Syphilis – not a matter of if, but when
